Wait for all kids to stop what they are doing and look up at you. This is soemthign that I do and kids should be really trained to do with a bit of encouragement. Nice job getting kids to get there materials. Nice and organized. All kids seem anxious too start. It is sometimes a good idea to give them a goal on how much to...you just told them they should have 20 circles trasced by the time they leave class today.

Kids are all working well. Nice movement around the room. Helping kids with questions and complimenting students.
