

**Employee Copy****Outline of Requirements For further Certification****PROVISIONAL RENEWAL - (Renewal only valid for up to 3 years)**

- First renewal requires completion of 10 semester hours in a planned course of study after the issuance of the provisional certificate or an approved master's or higher degree completed at any time.
- Second renewal requires completion of 18 semester hours in a planned course of study after the issuance of the provisional certificate or an approved master's or higher degree completed at any time.
- An additional three-year renewal requires sponsorship by the local school district or private school and approval of the Michigan Department of Education as well as the completion of all academic requirements for the Professional Education Certificate.

**PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION CERTIFICATE (valid up to 5 years)**

- Requires completion of 18 semester hours in a planned course of study after the issuance of the provisional certificate or an approved master's or higher degree completed at any time from an approved teacher preparation institution
- Three years of teaching experience within the validity of the certificate

**ADVANCED CERTIFICATE RENEWAL (Professional Education, School Psychologist, School Counselor, Occupational)**

- Requires completion of 6 semester hours at an accredited higher education institution or a Michigan Community college or 18 State Board Continuing Education Units (SB-CEU's) or a combination of the two (3 SB-CEU's are equivalent to 1 semester hour of credit).
- Only SB-CEUs and/or semester hours earned after the issuance date and within the immediate 5 year period preceding the date of application of certificate may be used toward certificate renewal.
